



## Racing Lane Modification Instructions

### TO LENGTHEN THE OVERALL LENGTH OF THE LANE FROM 75' (25YD) TO 25M (82') WITHOUT USING A 7' DISCONNECT

1. Lay Competitor® Racing lane on a flat surface or pool deck.
2. Release all slack on the Take Up Reel, so Blue Nylon spool is showing.
3. Locate set-screw on Take Up Reel Spool and loosen.
4. Remove cable from Spool. Please note the way the cable is threaded so reattachment is done in the proper manner.
5. Using the new 84' length of cable, splice the 84' length to the end of the lane using a small piece of tape. Gently slide off the 15' of solid color.
6. Remove the splice and add the new parts in the same pattern as the rest of the lane.
7. Reattach the splice and slide the remaining parts onto the new cable. Remove splice.
8. Remove the spring assembly from the 75' cable and carefully reattach it to the new cable. Please note how the cable is secured onto the cable lock inside the spring.
9. Re-thread cable back onto Take Up Reel Spool (remember to feed cable through the hole with no set screw first).
10. Tighten set screw firmly to complete modification.
